Lives by the Lord's grace (ability and favor), principles and promises (abundant Life). Lives to and for the Lord not self.		
— (2 Peter 1)		
The Lord's faith, hope, and love abide and control the believer.		
— (1 Corinthians 13)		
Produce good God-fruit for others as one is attached to Jesus.		
— (John 15)		
In the world, not of it. About the Lord's purpose and will (mission).		
— (John 15:18-25)		
Name is written in Book of Life, forever the Lord's child.		
— (Revelation 20:11-15)		
Born into this world (physical birth) to have opportunity to hear the gospel (good news about Jesus) and be "born again" (spiritually).		
— (John 1)		
The Lord lives within us enabling us to will and to do His good pleasure. The Law of Life and Health (not sin, sickness and death) control our lives.		
— (Philippians 2:12-18; Romans 8)		
Able to obey the Lord's commandments and not sin because of Jesus and the Lord's		

grace in us, working the Lord's will and purpose by the Holy Spirit.

— (Romans 8:4; Philippians 2:12-13)

Has direct access to the Lord. No need for mediator (Mary, saints, etc.) because the Father Himself loves the believer.

— (Hebrews 10; John 16:25-28)
